

English:

This half term we will be continuing to develop our reading, writing, spelling and grammar skills through a range of texts and genres:

- Gothic fiction - narrative focus
- Dystopian fiction - balanced argument/discussion focus
- Biography
- Visual Literacy - persuasion focus
- Poetry (Haiku)



Science:



In science this term we will be learning about the differences in the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. In the second half of the term our topic is Earth and Space looking at the movements of the Earth, moon and sun.

Maths

This term we will start by learning about place value in numbers up to 100,000 and moving on up to 1,000,000 as the term progresses. We will continue to develop and skills and strategies for mental addition and subtraction with 4 digit numbers and with up to 5 digit numbers using formal methods.

We will also learn how to use and interpret line graphs which display both discrete and continuous data. Children will also continue to develop their skills and strategies for multiplication and division including investigations on how to use factors and prime numbers and square and cube numbers.

We will compare the two stories of creation in the book of Genesis.
